
A Beatles Tribute: Classical Mystery Tour Friday October 13, 2017 - event starts at 8:00 PM

Get on I-75 N in Lenoir City from Tellico Pkwy and US-321S, follow I-75 N, take I-40 E and merge onto TN-158 W/James White Pkwy via Exit 388A toward Summit Hill Dr. Take ramp toward TN-158 W/Neyland Dr/Univ of TN, turn left onto E Summit Hill Dr, take 1st right onto Hall of Fame Dr, turn left onto Howard Baker Ave.

Imagine The Beatles playing in concert with a symphony orchestra. What would that have sounded like? Find out for yourself when Classical Mystery Tour performs live in concert. The four musicians in Classical Mystery Tour look and sound just like The Beatles, but Classical Mystery Tour is more than just a rock concert. The full show presents some 30 Beatles tunes sung, played, and performed exactly as they were written. Hear "Penny Lane" with a live trumpet section; experience the beauty of "Yesterday" with an acoustic guitar and string quartet; enjoy the rock/classical blend on the hard edged "I Am the Walrus." From early Beatles music on through the solo years, Classical Mystery Tour is the best of The Beatles like you've never heard them: totally live.

Classical Mystery Tour features Jim Owen (John Lennon) on rhythm guitar, piano, and vocals; Tony Kishman (Paul McCartney) on bass guitar, piano, and vocals; David John (George Harrison) on lead guitar and vocals; and Chris Camilleri (Ringo Starr) on drums and vocals. Martin Herman, who transcribed the musical scores note for note from Beatles recordings, conducts many of the Classical Mystery Tour concerts.
