



Hike 'n Lunch

Sequoyah Hills Park

Thursday, April 4, 2024

Depart Poplar Springs Boat Ramp promptly @ 8:15 AM,
please arrive 10 minutes before departure time

Rating: EASY, hard surface trail

Distance: 3.1 miles total

Elevation gain: 105 ft.

Brief Description of the Hike: We will walk a section of the Sequoyah Hills Trail in Knoxville. This is an urban hike through a prestigious old town neighborhood along the Tennessee River. The walk will be approximately 3.1 miles in length, on a mostly hard surfaced trail in the middle of Cherokee Boulevard. We will walk the level sections of the trail with only about 100' total elevation change.

Drive time to the park is approximately 45 minutes. Parking is ample and readily available. We will park in the Sequoyah Park Restrooms Parking lot. Restrooms with flush toilets are available on-site.

Directions to Sequoyah Hills Park (from Poplar Springs boat ramp)

Note: If you are using Google Maps, input "Sequoyah Park Restrooms; Sequoyah Greenway, Knoxville"

Proceed north on Tellico Parkway, through Lenoir City to the I-75 on ramp towards Knoxville (approximately 8 miles). Merge onto I-75N, towards Knoxville, for 18 miles to exit 383 (TN332). Follow TN332 to merge into Northshore Drive for 1.6 miles. Turn left onto Lyons View Pike for 1.4 miles. Turn right onto Arrowhead Trail SW (0.3 miles), Turn right onto Blows Ferry Rd SW (0.3 miles). Proceed onto Cherokee Blvd. for 0.2 miles. Turn right into the parking lot at Sequoyah Hills Restrooms. We will park in this lot during our walk.

After the Hike: Proceed to "Dead End Barbeque" restaurant for lunch. Directions will be provided on the morning of the hike

(Note: In the case of inclement weather, we will suggest that the group should plan to come to Dead End Barbeque for a very enjoyable group lunch at 11:15 AM.)

Attendees are responsible for their own meals and drinks
