This is a group educational tour, approximately 1.5 hours long and will cover the African Grasslands, Tiger Forest, Valley of the Kings, and Chimp Ridge. Knoxville Zoo has over 700 animals. While the zoo is small in comparison to many zoos we will get a guided tour and valuable information on the various species.

- This tour will culminate with a keeper chat on a specific animal.
- Lunch can be purchased on site **or** bring your own bag lunch.
- Tables for sit down are limited to first come first serve, but we will break for lunch after our guided tour and find a place to eat.
- After lunch we will have our keeper chat of a specific animal. (Not yet determined)
- You will be free to roam the zoo after that if you wish. We estimate that we will complete our tour around 1:30 - 2 PM. Pending demonstrations.
- Where comfortable clothing and shoes, as you know this will be a walking tour.

There are also various demonstrations with animals, but there is no schedule ahead of time. You will have an opportunity to attend these demonstrations pending what is available that day. As we near the date we will get a better schedule of what is available for demonstrations and try to fit into our tour and hand out a detailed agenda upon arrival
