Muddy Boots Hike – Stinging Fork Falls & Twin Rocks

Hike Description: This pair of short day hikes has trailheads that are only 4 miles apart. The Stinging Forks Falls (2.1 miles) is an out-and-back hike that makes its way to a pretty waterfall, with an additional spur to the Indian Head Overlook. The Twin Rocks hike (2.2 miles) visits a segment of the lower Piney River, using the Cumberland Trail and connector paths to make a scenic waterside loop with an optional spur to a rocky overlook that requires climbing a ladder and crossing a bridge.
