

This Charles Dickens holiday classic comes to life as a charming live 1940s radio broadcast, complete with vintage commercials, the magic of live sound effects, and musical underscoring from the golden age of radio.

Have you always wanted to try your hand at acting, but were not sure you could memorize lines? In a radio broadcast, the actors have the scripts in their hands! Each actor will be a radio actor who is playing several characters. This gives the actor the opportunity to use different voices developed for each character.

The cast: Five men, four women, and a non-speaking role as a foley artist who is responsible for the live sound effects during the show.

Auditioners will be cold reading from the script for different characters. Attendance at only one audition date is required; you will audition in order of arrival. Rehearsals will be 3-4 nights per week at 6:30 pm, Monday thru Thursday, beginning Tuesday, October 23.
